# **TOUR DESCRIPTIONS**

## **CITY TOUR / PEARSON AIR MUSEUM**

Wednesday, September 2

Not-to-miss sites during a tour of Portland include the Forecourt Fountain, Salmon Street Springs in Waterfront Park, and Pioneer Courthouse Square. Located in the heart of downtown Portland, Pioneer Courthouse Square is affectionately known as the City's "living room." With more than 26,000 people passing by the Square each day, and thousands more visiting the Square directly, it is the single most visited site in Oregon's most visited city. Enjoy lunch in Nob Hill, a unique community of shops, businesses, and restaurants in Portland. We'll end the day crossing the bridge into Vancouver to tour the Pearson Air Museum, located on Pearson Field, one of the nation's oldest operating airfields. Learn about all the aviation milestones that have occurred at this small Vancouver field since 1905. Step into our pre-WW II Army Air Corps hangars and immerse yourself in Pacific Northwest aviation history! Experience the "Golden Age of Aviation," when flying was new to the world and those who flew in open cockpit aircraft, with the wind in their faces, were the ultimate daredevils! Enter the museum and you enter a world of wild barnstormers, experimental aircraft, and aces of World War I and II. Watch a film, see lots of memorabilia, and visit the gift shop.

## **NORTH COAST / MARITIME MUSEUM**

Thursday, Sept 3

Sit back and enjoy a day of breathtaking beauty as you travel west through fir forests and the Coastal Mountain Range. Visit Camp 18, an old logging museum, located in a log cabin style complex. Stroll among five acres of restored logging history. You'll discover steam shovels, cranes, cabooses, and scores of interesting "old time" logging classics. There is a small gift shop on the premises. Continue the tour to Cannon Beach, a shoppers' and art lovers' paradise. There you can see the infamous haystack rock, one of Oregon's signature near-shore "sea stack" rock formation. Enjoy a boxed lunch and free time to shop in the quaint beach town. Take a refreshing walk along the shore, before you re-board the bus to Astoria, the oldest American settlement in the West. View the famous Astor Column atop 635-foot Coxcomb Hill. Tour the Columbia River Maritime Museum. Explore 200 years of Pacific Northwest maritime history as guides take you through exhibits on shipwrecks, fishing, sailing vessels, and naval history. See the actual navigation bridge of the WWII destroyer USS Knapp, and go on board the lightship Columbia. Moored next to the museum, it was the last U.S. Coast Guard lightship to serve on the West Coast. On the way back to Portland, follow the scenic south bank of the mighty Columbia River through small towns and historic points of interest.

## **LUNCH CRUISE**

Thursday, Sept 3

On the Portland Spirit, enjoy a two-hour lunch cruise on the beautiful Willamette River. This 130-foot yacht with two fully enclosed climate-controlled dining levels, has eighty large windows so that every seat has a glorious view of the scenery. All meals are freshly prepared on board, featuring the finest Northwest cuisine. Once seated, your server will inform you of three entrées to choose from, then promptly serve you at your table. All entrée selections are served with salad, bread, and a beverage. Afterwards, enjoy the soft breezes on three outdoor viewing decks. A cash bar is available.

## **COLUMBIA RIVER GORGE**

Friday, September 4

Spend the day in Oregon's natural wonderland. The road to Hood River parallels the Columbia River. As you tour through the magnificent Columbia River Gorge, view the basalt cliffs thousands of feet high and take the old scenic highway past Multnomah Falls, the highest of numerous falls seen along the Columbia River Gorge. Stop at the Hood River Inn and enjoy a sit-down lunch in the dining room overlooking the river. This is truly a Scenic tour that you won't want to miss. Bring the cameras!

## **CITY TOUR AND EVERGREEN AVIATION MUSEUM**

Friday, September 4

Join the dream to fly and explore the fascinating world of aviation history. You will have up-close and personal encounters with an extensive vintage aircraft collection including Howard Hughes' massive Flying boat, "Spruce Goose". You will be inspired by their collection of aircraft and aviation artifacts while experiencing the thrill of aviation through exciting exhibits, demonstrations, events and educational activities. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the two cafés on site – the Spruce Goose Café and the Cosmo Café. On the return trip enjoy a one hour driving tour of Portland, including the Forecourt Fountain opposite the Civic Auditorium, Salmon Street Springs in Waterfront Park, and Pioneer Courthouse Square, Portland's outdoor living room.
